Volunteer Camp Buddy

Position Description:

Volunteering under the supervision of the Camp Director and Coordinator of Volunteer Services, Camp Buddies are teaming up with one or two campers who need additional support with engaging in games and activities. Camp Buddies assist the Camp Director and L.I.T.s with the daily supervision and care of campers. Successful candidates demonstrate energy enthusiasm and patience's, are a positive role model and have a team focused attitude.

Volunteering as a Camp Buddy is a one week, full-time commitment. Hours are 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday.

Job Description:

1. Attend pre-camp training session and daily check in meetings
2. Supervise assigned camper during all activities and lunch time
Camp Buddies are Not required to provide personal support (i.e. toileting and feeding)
3. Support a safe environment for all campers, volunteers and staff
4. Help maintain a clean and well organized facility
5. Uphold and adhere to the policies and procedures of SARI Therapeutic Riding

Minimum requirements:

- Camp Buddies must be a least 14 years of age
- Reliable transportation to and from SARI
- Must be a current SARI volunteer OR attend a training session prior to volunteer start date
- Previous camp experience and/or experience working with children and youth with special needs is an asset
- Criminal Reference Check
