### **Position Description:**

This position is designed to support and encourage the development of SARI Volunteers. Successful candidates will have experience working with children or volunteer at SARI. Have strong initiative skills, be energetic and responsible.

This leadership role is a two week full-time commitment. Hours are 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. In addition to experiencing a valuable learning opportunity, L.I.T.'s will receive a letter of reference in recognition of their service.

### **Job Description:**

1. Attend pre-camp training sessions and daily check in meetings
2. Supervise assigned Camp Volunteers, campers and support workers
3. Facilitate and supervise camp activities, horsemanship lessons and guest speakers/presentations
4. Implement a safe environment for all campers, volunteers and staff
5. Help maintain a clean and well organized facility
6. Uphold and adhere to the policies and procedures of SARI Therapeutic Riding

- Reliable transportation to and from SARI required
- Must be a current SARI volunteer OR attend a training session prior to volunteer start date
- Previous camp experience and/or experience working with children and youth with special needs an asset
