### Summer Program Volunteers

#### Position Description:

Volunteering under the supervision of the Head Instructor and Coordinator of Volunteer Services, the Camp Director. Leaders in Training and Summer Program Volunteers support the facilitation of therapeutic riding lessons by leading and/or side walking with campers and/or riders participating in private lessons.

Hours are Monday-Friday 8:30am-12:30pm and/or Wednesdays 12:30-8:30pm. Volunteers are asked to make a commitment of at least one day per week, or on a fill in basis throughout the summer.

#### Job Description:

1. Arrive 30 minutes prior to lesson start time to participate in the grooming and tacking of the horses
2. Remain approximately 20 minutes after the end of class to help groom and untack the horses and return equipment to its' proper place
3. Provide at least 24 hours notice if they will be absent from their class
4. Support a safe environment for all riders, volunteers and staff
5. Help maintain a clean and well organized facility
6. Uphold and adhere to the policies and procedures of SARI Therapeutic Riding

#### Minimum requirements:

- Summer Program Volunteers must be a least 14 years of age
- Reliable transportation to and from SARI
- Must be a current SARI volunteer OR attend a training session prior to volunteer start date
- Criminal Reference Check
